

## Lesson 51. यण्सन्धिः ।

We have been dealing with the अ/आ so far. The rest of the swaras can't wait to be discussed as well.

These are the rules to follow:

	First word ending in		Next word beginning with		Results in
1.	इ/ ई	followed by	any other swara but for इ/ ई	=	इ/ ई changing to य्
2.	उ/ ऊ	followed by	any other swara but for उ/ ऊ	=	उ/ ऊ changing to व्
3.	ऋ/ ॠ	followed by	any other swara but for ऋ/ ॠ	=	ऋ/ ॠ changing to र्
4.	ऌ / ॡ	followed by	any other swara but for ऌ / ॡ	=	ऌ / ॡ changing to ल्

Then the changed swara of the first word gets added to the swara of the next word AGAIN to form a new letter.

Here are examples for each of them:

1. प्रति + एकम्

प्रत् + य् + एकम् = प्रत्येकम् ।

2. मनु + अन्तरम्

मन् + व् + अन्तरम् = मन्वन्तरम् ।

3. पितृ + इच्छा

पित् + र् + इच्छा = पित्रिच्छा

4. घस्लृ + आदेशः

घस् + ल् + आदेशः = घस्लादेशः ।
