UNFORGETABLE REMINISCENCES

MY PUJYA ANANDASHRAM SWAMIJI

My first meeting with Anandashram Swamiji was in June 1951. The Canara Union Hall had been just built, and one of the first functions was my thread ceremony.

after my Thread Ceremony, Anandashram Swamiji visited Bangalore and stayed in Canara Union. In the evening several people performed Pada Puja and I was one of them. This is etched deeply in my mind. When I was getting up my "kasu" of my Pitambar got entangled in my leg and slipped down, I grabbed it and held in my hand when prostrating. Swamiji gave a big smile and blessed me. Several years later, when Swamiji visited Sri Krishna temple, we were all volunteers and later Late Ved Vishveshwar Bhatji was introducing the Volunteers to Swamiji, my turn came and I prostrated. HH Swamiji gave a broad smile and said I need not be introduced as he knows me very well as a boy who danced on the Canara Union Stage with "KASU" in his hand. I felt so happy that he could remember such a small incident.

After this, I had a chance to meet Swamiji during his visits to Bangalore.

Two more incidents happened in my life, which taught me a lot and have become my guidelines.

During my first visit to Shirali, somewhere in late 1950's, I and my brother, with my father were invited by Swamiji for His evening walk. We went up to Murudeshwar temple in the Car and later went for a walk on the beach. When Swamiji was about 10 steps ahead of us, we found shells of different shapes and started asking our father some questions about shells. Our father said, "you are disturbing Swamiji, so ask me questions when we reach back our room". Swamiji suddenly stopped and beckoned us and what he said is deeply engraved in my brain and I have followed it all the time.

Swamiji asked my father- "Bhavanishanker, do you know the answer for the question?" My father said yes. Swamiji said, "answer it now, otherwise children will forget the question and there will be a blank in their knowledge." After our father explained, Swamiji gave a discourse on various types of Shankha and how it was used in communication. He explained about its use in Kurukshetra war. He advised all of us, "if you don't know the answer, ask and read but don't be blank about the answers."

My next incident was in 1963, HH Swamiji was in Bangalore. I received a call from Indian Air Force for an Interview in Gwalior for Pilots. I had 'A' license in flying and age factor was overlooked due to

Emergency. I and Pappa, went to Math and met Swamiji and sought His blessings. Swamiji's words were, "We will pray to Lord Bhavanishanker and let Him bless you with what is good for you".

Fortunately or unfortunately I did not get selected. Later when I returned to Bangalore, a bit disappointed, my father reminded me of Swamiji's blessings. He told me that it might not be my destiny. Some of the boys who came for the interview were trained in Bangalore on transport planes-AVRO. They used to come to our home whenever they were home sick. It is unfortunate that about four of them lost their lives in accidents. I always remember His blessings. You do your best and leave to God the rest.

Another incident, where Swamiji's observation power is highlighted, happened in reference to my grandfather, Shinajja. Whenever Swamiji was in Bangalore, Ajja would take a tray of flowers for Pooja. The flowers were arranged as per the Mantra of Pushpa Samarpan. They were specially grown by him in the garden. One day he was a bit late in reaching the Math. Swamiji asked Surya Bhatji "āji Shina yenive", because the flower-tray was not there. Ajja reached 10 minutes later and the tray was sent in. Swamiji remarked "Shina ailve".

One more very significant step taken by Swamiji was ending the "Bahishkar" imposed on those people who travelled abroad. An incident happened in Bangalore involving my maternal grandfather Dr. Basrur Sanjiv Rao, who was at that time President of Canara Union. Swamiji used to be hosted by

Canara Union, but Ajja could not go in front of Swamiji. He would go to Canara Union at 5 a.m. and leave by 6 a.m., after making arrangements and return after 10 p.m. to again organize things. Swamiji heard him giving instructions, but had not seen him. He asked Surva Bhatji to find out who he was. When He found out, He asked Surva Bhatji to invite him to meet and discuss. He told him to invite all those people who were in the list and did "Shuddi karan". Lots of elitist came back into the community again. Many of them paid high Vantigas. Swamiji said, "time may come when most of our community members may go abroad and return, and there will be nobody left in our community if the Bahishkar were to continue." His forethought saved our community. At present at least one member from each family goes abroad and our community would have ceased to exist, had the ban continued.

I always remember the very sweet smile Swamiji used to give everybody.

TEACHINGS OF SWAMI PARIJNANASHRAM

(Summary of a talk with His Holiness Shrimat Parijnanashram Swamiji at "Shri Anandashram", Khar, on Sunday 28-09-1978.)

Question: We are supposed to be Rigvedi Smārta Brahmins and our community deity is Lord Bhavanishankar. Yet, our tradition is Bhāgavata Dharma. How is it so?

His Holiness: Our tradition is to show equal reverence to all gods. Even among Smārtas, there are pure Smārtas and the Smārta Bhāgavats. Generally we follow the tradition laid down by Adi Shankaracharya who initiated Panchāyatan Puja with the following words:

आदित्यम् अंबिकां विष्णुं गणनाथं महेश्वरम्। पंचयज्ञपरो नित्यं पंचदेवान् प्रपूजयेत्।।

Adityam here stands for the sun, Ambikā for Shakt, Vishnu, Gananatha for Ganapati the Lord Protector and Maheshwara for Shiva. They are the five पूर्ति-s we are asked to worship. So, also, we are exhorted to perform five Yagnas or Panchayagnas which are: Manushya Yagna (service of guests), Deva Yagna (worship of the Deity), Rishi Yagna (Veda-Pathan), Pitru Yagna (offerings to the manes) and Bhuta Yagna (feeding the birds and animals like cows, crows, and other creatures).

Our tradition of Bhagavata Dharma was given to us by Adi Shankara himself. We came to worship Lord Bhavanishankar because His idol was installed by Adi Parijnanashram and He gave us Bhavanishankar as our Ishta-devata.

Question: What is the relevance of Bhagavata Dharma to the present times and how can we who live in towns and cities follow its tenets?

His Holiness: As Parampujya Anandashram Swamiji taught us, in our daily life, whatever we do let us take it that we are doing only in service of God. If we can practice this in our day-to-day life, no matter where we are situated, we will be practising Bhagavata Dharma itself. Whatever we see before us we should take as forms of God. If we can do this, this itself is Bhagavata Dharma. But, we should practise this daily, we should have Abhyasa. We should repose firm faith in Guru's word and carry out this tenet in daily life. The fruit of Bhagavata Dharma is Moksha or liberation which is attainment of Brahman. Repose, therefore, the greatest faith in Shastras and the Guru and learn to see Him in all. Once we come to realise that the cause of action, action and the actor are one and the same, we begin to enjoy the first fruits of Bhagavata Dharma as a matter of course. The most difficult of all is to see God in others. But, as we strive for this vision, it becomes easier and easier. Just as we show eagerness for worldly objects, so also we come to replace this with eagerness for God and it makes us see God in all. And, once we reach

this state, God sees to it that there is no fall from it. A man who begins to see God in everyone sees God in his persecutors also. Even if the evil-doers do him any harm, he sees no wrong, takes it that it is God who has done it and that God has done it for his own good. This state of complete surrender to God is the highest state a Sadhaka can attain. In that state, Karma even does not affect him.

Question: What is the real significance of the Gayatri mantra and what does the Gayatri stand for?

His Holiness: Gayatri has been with us from time immemorial. It is said that this mantra was handed down by Brahma Himself. As for its meaning, it is as follows:

Savitur: One who is the Cause of creation, preservation and destruction, Who is all-pervading, all-knowing and all-protecting;

Tat-varenyam: The most adorable Brahman, Who is the Self in all creatures, One Who is the goal of all, the state which all have to reach;

Devasya Bhargaha: He is the radiant One Who removes all darkness and brings forth light of Self-knowledge (Atma Jnana), Who is Lustre Himself and before Whom all darkness flees;

Dhimahi : I contemplate on such a Tatwa, such a Truth Eternal;

Dhiyo yo naha: He is the Buddhi (intellect) in us;

Prachodayãt: Let our intellect turn inward towards Him. Let me be one with such a Swaroop.

The Gayatri is the essence of all life. It should become the essence of our life too. When we attain this state we get liberation from all sins and attain divine knowledge. We have to chant the Gayatri with this "bhavana". The Vedas tell us "Yo Arthajnaha Sakalam Bhadramashnute'. If we follow all the rules of Gayatri repetition, we can realise the fruits of Gayatri Japa sooner. Gayatri is a Vedic mantra, and we are asked to do 24 lakhs of Gayatri to attain its spiritual fruit of Self-knowledge. Those who cannot do all the Japa, are advised (as Pujya Anandashram Swami used to say) to do at least five Gayatri japas daily with all devotion and sincerity. That is sufficient to take us to the goal. Just as a child always looks upto its mother for everything, we should do the Gayatri japa like a child remembering his mother. Gayatri is, indeed, our Mother.

Question: What is Pujya Swamiji's main advice to the community today?

His Holiness: Our main teaching is only this - we should endeavour to perform Panchāyatan puja as illustrated earlier (above), we should do Gayatri japa, and learn to see Paramatman in all. Then we will attain Brahma Tatwa or knowledge of Brahman. This is all that we have to say.

The Joy of Satsanga - A Blessing from the Guru

We pray at the Feet of the Guru; all situations are changing in the samaja. But our intensity should not decline. We must experience that more and more. Ten years back I had heard something called Adhyatmika spiritual, now that time has come in my life. It is fructifying. Each sadhaka is entitled to that satisfaction.

Kalena cha pachyate ... one fourth ... that much time is required, to reach a matured state.

(Note – "kalen cha pachyate – one fourth" means – one gets one fourth knowledge from the Guru, one fourth by his intellect, one fourth through the classmates and the remaining one fourth is assimilated through time alone).

Not feverish, very focused. This should be experienced by every sadhaka, so we pray at the Feet of the Guru on behalf of all of you. This much if We pray for, it is indeed enough. All this happens, because you have tried. One receives Blessings of Guru in the form of His being pleased and whatever we need in life immediately – happiness peace, abundance. That is indeed attained as prasada, it need not even be mentioned, as long as this focus is not lost. Practice and letting

go, vairagya, as maturity comes according to our age, maturity should go on increasing. We learn, others learn because of us, we learn from each other too. A sadhaka who has learnt to turn his mind inwards, mutual learning takes place effortlessly. The joy that is in it, in reality, that is the joy of satsanga. Not only that, tears flow from the eyes on listening to something or in a state of great happiness, real satsanga happens by doing things together. May that joy be attained by all, We pray thus at the Feet of the Guru.

Generate Vairagya in Karmakshetra through Abhyasa

For example, take going across. Ok, do not get so agitated. But as a sport take swimming. You need water, but you don't want to drown in it. While swimming, let's say free style though there are many types, definitely there is a time when your head was under water. You need the water to enjoy the sport of swimming. You can sink if you do (try to breathe in water)if you are an ass. If you have the कला, the skill, you can float, but if you want to move ahead, you have to learn to breathe and you cannot breathe water. And if there is no water, you are just on land; you cannot enjoy swimming. So, that is your condition. There is water, one must keep in mind vairagya while in it. Learn to breathe intermittently and you also have to learn that you do not breathe in water. Then your progress is faster. You acquire a new skill. Guru Shakti is happy. Hmm.... we are not to make

ourselves totally indifferent, dry, get dry cleaned and sit. We have our prarabhda, we have to move forward. That comes as this water. It comes as a karmakshetra. If we have the skill to move forward in that, if we want to breathe, we still have to look up. That is your practice. So, every time to practice your daily japa, if you make up a set of माला-s say, once, twice, etc. In that practice too, using the same japa, there is a different abhvasa to strengthen the vairagya and chant the same Japa in a different way to attach the mind towards God. When you do it with visualization, the mind gains strength, it gets connected. Japa is going on and when you sit quietly, just feeling a bit sleepy, I will sit and do my japa for fifteen minutes before going to sleep - when you practice like this, vairagya begins to step in. You consolidate. At that time, mind is calm. Whatever sankalpa I have taken in vyavahara - I tend to react like this. I will not. I take a sankalpa like this. I tried a little and got 50% success. As per the sankalpa when we change our attitude, behavior, control reactions and after calming down when we do our japa at night, almost at that time again the utthapana (the rising up) happens. Should it have been done in this way? Should this have been said? There is no resistance. You just let go of that. Call it insistence, justification etc., this letting go happens at that time. Do you understand? What is the support? Breathing! Japa is going on. Fifteen minutes, twenty minutes, with that resolve that I am not going to get agitated, I am not going to carry on with my conversations that are going on in my mind. Anyway I want to go to sleep after this. There

is peace. Japa has to be done at that time. Do you understand? So, you have practised. It must be done every day, but more than that, even in the karmakshetra, your field of activity. If detachment has to develop, that is an art you need to learn. Seva brings in purification, both are attained.

The aim of one's life should be the realisation of the highest Truth.

The Shāstrās are numerous and profound. For those seekers who are equipped with good intellect, the Shāstrās point out the ephemeral nature of the world and term it a mere appearance. A number of aspects such as Jiva (the individual consciousness), Isvara (the divine consciousness responsible for creation), Jagat (the created universe) and bandha (bondage) are detailed for the seekers.

The Shāstrās, leading the seeker step by step in his spiritual journey, finally unfold the oneness of all in the non- dual Absolute Brahman.

Sri Shankara Bhagavatpada in his Shatashloki expresses this lucidly.

स्वं बालं रोदमानं चिरतरसमयं शान्तिमानेतुमग्रे द्राक्षं खार्जूरमाम्नं सुकदलमथवा योजयत्यम्बिकाऽस्य। तद्वच्चेत्तोऽतिमूढं बहुजननभवान्मौढयसंस्कारयोगात् । बोधोपायैरनेकैरवशमुपनिषद्गोधयामास सम्यक् ।।

Just as a mother in order to pacify her child crying for a very long time, places before him grapes, dates, a mango or a good plantain fruit, the Upanishads by various teaching expedients, enlighten the ignorant and restless mind caught in

the throes of its deep-rooted tendencies acquired over numerous lives.


As the Shastras cannot be compltely understood by oneself, a prescribed mode of instruction is necessary. Hence, upadesha (instruction) from a realised Guru is very important.

The Guru knows what the Shāstrās prescribe, and accordingly instructs the seeker, on the particular mode of sadhana suited to his capacity.

The key to securing lasting peace, joy and contentment in all places and conditions is the grace of the Guru alone. Hence one should worship the Guru with implicit faith in him.

We bless all to ubderstand this and progress along the journey from darkness of ignorance to the divine light Supreme.

94) यक्षगेयात्मवैभव :

Whose soul-glory has been sung by the yaksha.

The yaksha here may mean the king of the demigods, Lord Kubera who is a great devotee of Lord Shiva and accepted by him as his special friend (देव सखा) Or, it maybe any of the yakshas whose main function is to sing the praises of the Lord, along with the Gandharvas and Kinnāras.

A deeper meaning may be attributed to this unusual name by referring the yaksha to the Kenopanishad story: Brahman himself appears as a yaksha in order to reveal his own glory and save the Gods from the danger of being overcome by ignorance and ego which made them think "This is our victory, our glory". Humbled and instructed, they realized that it was all atma-vaibhava only.

There is a variation of the name according to which it reads as 'yagna-geyatma-vaibhava'. The Lord's glories are sung in the yagnas. The 'yagna' by definition is (देवता उद्देशेन द्रव्य त्याग) offering of things for



the sake of the Lord. The offerings have to be accompanied by chanting of mantras decreed for the purpose. These mantras are beautiful expositions of the God-consciousness that pervades the universe.

Alternatively, we may take 'yajna' in the spiritual context in which Gita uses it. Whole life-process is 'Yagna', self-offering of the Lord. When a sadhaka fashions his life in tune with this music of the universe, his own soulnature is manifest and he attains to everlastingness. 'He who enjoys whatever comes out of yagna attains to the everlasting Brahman' (Gita 4.31)

Yet a third meaning can be derived from the yajna reading, if we take the yajna as referring to the one performed by Daksha Prajapati. it was designed to disgrace Lord Shiva; but actually, in its destruction by Mother Sati's poignant protest and consequent Virabhadra's conquest, the glory of Shiva was evident and established firmly.

श्री चित्रपुर मठ - शिराली (उत्तर कन्नड़, कर्नाटक)

श्री चित्रापुर मठ उत्तर कन्नड, कर्नाटक के शिराली में स्थित, चित्रापुर सारस्वत समुदाय का प्रमुख आध्यात्मिक केंद्र है। यह मठ भगवान भवानीशंकर, देवी भुवनेश्वरी, श्री गणपित और श्री आदि शंकराचार्य की प्रतिष्ठित मूर्तियों तथा एक समृद्ध 300 वर्ष पुरानी गुरु परंपरा का परम धाम है। इसकी स्थापना 1757 में परम पुज्य शंकराश्रम स्वामीजी प्रथम की समाधि के साथ हुई थी। मठ परिसर में छह मठाधिपतियों की समाधियाँ और 10वें मठाधिपति की पादुका सन्निधि भी हैं।

मठ का वातावरण वैदिक मंत्रों, विविध पूजा और हवन से निरंतर गूंजता है। यहां हर साधक को प्रेम, शांति और गुरु कृपा की अनुभृति होती है। सभी प्रमुख हिंदू पर्व और गुरु पूजन समारोह पारंपरिक उल्लास के साथ मनाए जाते हैं। वर्तमान में परम पूज्य श्री सद्योजात शंकराश्रम स्वामीजी इस पवित्र गुरु परंपरा के संवाहक और प्रमुख हैं।

श्री काशी मठ संस्थान

एक पावन आध्यात्मिक केंद्र है, जहाँ मठाधिपति प्रतिदिन तीन बार श्री वेदव्यास, भगवान रघुपति (राम) और श्री नरिसंह के विग्रहों का पूजन-अभिषेक करते हैं। गुरुकुल में ब्रह्मचारी वेद, शास्त्र, काव्य व नाटद्ध की शिक्षा लेते हैं, जबकि संन्यासी वैराग्यपूर्ण जीवन जीकर भक्ति व जनकल्याण में रत रहते हैं।

श्री काशी मठ संस्थान सारस्वत ब्राह्मण समुदाय का एक प्रमुख धार्मिक एवं आध्यात्मिक केंद्र है, वर्तमान 21वें मठाधिपति श्रीमद सम्यामिन्द्र तीर्थ स्वामीजी हैं, जो मठ के सभी धार्मिक और प्रशासनिक कार्यों का संचालन करते हैं तथा यहाँ के प्रमुख देवता व्यास रघुपति नरसिंह (भगवान वेद व्यास, श्री राम और नरसिंह) की प्रतिदिन तीन बार (सुबह, दोपहर व रात) पूजा-अर्चना करते हैं।

श्री कैवल्य मठ

श्री कैवल्य मठ (या श्री कवले मठ), जो सारस्वत ब्राह्मण समुदाय का सबसे पुराना मठ है, गोवा में स्थित है और इसके मुख्य देवता श्री भवानीशंकर हैं। इस मठ की स्थापना 1630 में हुई थी, जब श्रीमद सच्चिदानंद सरस्वती इसके पहले गुरुस्वामी बने। वर्तमान में, मठ के 75वें गुरु श्री स्वामी सच्चिदानंद सरस्वती हैं, जबकि परम पुज्य श्रीमद शिवानंद सरस्वती इसके 76वें मठाधीश (वर्तमान प्रमुख) के रूप में कार्यरत हैं। यह मठ अपनी धार्मिक एवं सांस्कृतिक विरासत के लिए प्रसिद्ध है और समुदाय के लिए एक महत्वपूर्ण आध्यात्मिक केंद्र के रूप में कार्य करता है।

श्री गोकर्ण मठ

श्री संस्थान गोकर्ण पार्टगली जीवोत्तम मठ (श्री गोकर्ण मठ) गोवा के दक्षिण गोवा में पार्टगल और पोइंगुइनिम गांवों के बीच क्शावती नदी के तट पर स्थित एक प्रमुख हिंदु मठ है, जिसकी स्थापना 1475 ई. में सारस्वत ब्राह्मण समुदाय के लिए धार्मिक, सांस्कृतिक और आध्यात्मिक केंद्र के रूप में हुई थी। यह मठ श्री माधवाचार्य के द्वैत दर्शन का पालन करता है और पूजा, शिक्षा व ध्यान का महत्वपूर्ण स्थल है। इसमें 500 वर्ष पुराना विशाल बरगद का पेड (ब्रह्मस्थान) है, जिसकी 220 हवाई जडें 72x70 मीटर क्षेत्र में फैली हैं, साथ ही एक लिंगम (शिव प्रतीक) भी स्थित है। यहाँ वेद-उपनिषदों पर शिक्षा, प्रवचन आदि गतिविधियाँ आयोजित की जाती हैं, जो गोवा की सांस्कृतिक विरासत का अहम हिस्सा है।

श्री गोकर्ण मठ के वर्तमान प्रमुख श्री विद्याधीश तीर्थ स्वामीजी हैं।श्री विद्याधिराज तीर्थ स्वामीजी 23वें मठाधीश हैं







And then they came back, together evermore— some for the first time, some with cherished memories from before.

Toran-s were hung and *rangoli*-s graced the space, obvious joy radiated on every face.

Hands threaded blossoms into garlands exquisite, warm light filled the *mandir* as *diya*-s were lit.

With flowers and fruits, *paleru*-s were filled; during the *Maha-aarti*, time itself stilled.

Prasad bhojan was served with compassion and care, every morsel a blessing, every plate a prayer.

Some managed the crowds with patience and grace, others guided the elderly to a comforting place.

For some, behind the curtain, their unseen hands stayed, weaving each detail, seamlessly laid.

As twilight descended, through the Deepanamaskaara, the Guru Parampara was revered, and the Shankarnarayan Geet and Mangala-pada were melodiously rendered.

Chants rose like rivers joining the sea, hands moved in service; hearts moved in harmony.

The air was perfumed with incense and song, a reminder that in Guru Seva, we all belong.

Like the *vanara*-s building Rama's bridge of stone, it was neither mine nor yours, but ours—our very own!

Ours to pursue, ours to serve, ours to stumble and rise, ours to experience, ours to grow, ours to worship, yearn, and bow.

And then they came back, together evermore, like waves, finding their way back to the shore.

Ammi Shikyaan - Puja - why do we perform Puja?

We perform *Puja* to connect with the Deity for our *Upasana*. We invite the Lord just as we invite guests, welcome Him respectfully to come and accept our *seva*, offering and *Puja*. There are *shodasha* or 16 *upachara-s* performed, where offerings are made along with *mantra-s* chanted. The *mantra-s* are from the *Purana-s*, known as *kalpokta mantra-s*.

Before we perform Puja, we ensure that the surroundings are clean

and we are purified from within, through the Puja Purvanga.

Aachamanam, pranayama, swasti vachanam, prarthana, sankalpa
- the sacred vow to complete the Puja, ghanta pujanam - prayers to the bell, Varuna dhyanam, kalasha pujanam and prarthana, shankha pujanam for the conch shell, prokshanam and atma prokshanam, asana shuddhi - prayers to Mother Earth, digbandha - prayers to all the Gods in all the directions, deepaka pujanam - prayers to the lamp, and Bhairava namaskar—all are a part of the Puja Purvanga.

In the *prarthana*, we seek blessings from our Guru-s, Lord Ganesha, Lord Bhavanishankar, Lord Uma-Maheshwara, Lord Lakshmi-Narayana, Lord Brahma with His Consort Devi Saraswati, Lord Indra with Shachi, the *Ishta Devata*-s, Family Deities, the *Grama Devata*, *Sthana Devata*, *Vastu Devata*, all the other *Deva*-s and the great *Mahapurusha-s*, before we begin the *Puja*. We pray to Lord Ganesha to enable us to complete our *sankalpa* without any obstacles.

The *Puja* then begins with the *Dhyana Mantra*, where we dwell upon the form, figure, features and personality of the Deity. *Avahanam* is performed next, with which we invite and welcome the Deity. We then offer an *Asanam*, for the Deity to take a seat. We welcome the Deity by washing Their feet and hands, offering water, a bath, new clothes, fresh flowers, fruits, incense, lamps, food in the form of *naivedyam*, *mukha shuddhi* and *dakshina*. We also perform *arati*, *prarthana and pranama*. After the *Puja* is completed, we bid the Lord farewell, begging forgiveness for any mistakes committed unwittingly or due to oversight. Once our connection with the Deity is established, we seat the Lord in our heart lotus, while bidding goodbye and offering our *seva* and *japa* or meditation to the Lord.

Thus, when we feel close to the Lord, whatever we do is offered to the Lord as *seva*. This establishes a deep connection with the Lord and gives us a sense of purpose and direction. When our actions are as if in prayer or *seva* to the Lord, we are less likely to commit wrong-doing, ensuring purity in our actions, our heart and mind.

Shankha Aasana Atma-shuddhi Naivedyam

Adi Shankarcharya – 5. Shankara finds his Guru

In our last issue, we read about how Shankara got permission from his mother to give up worldly life and become a *Sannyasi*. Entrusting the care of his mother to his relatives, he began his journey in search of a Guru.

Assuming the staff of a *Sannyasi* and clad in saffron robes, Shankara passed through various lands—forests, rivers, cities, countryside and mountains. Travelling a long distance, the young *Sannyasin* arrived at the forest hermitage of Sage Govindapadacharya on the banks of the Narmada one evening. Desirous of being initiated into the knowledge of *Brahman*, he sought the advice of the ascetic inhabitants of the place. As directed by them, he approached Sage Govinda Bhagavatpada's residence — a cave with an entrance only a cubit in width. (A cubit is an ancient unit of length that is the distance from the elbow to the tip of the middle finger.)

Shankara went around the cave thrice, and then, falling

prostrate at its door, began to chant a hymn in praise of Sage Govindapada, filled with the spirit of devotion. Shri Govinda Bhagavatpada, who intuitively knew the greatness of this extraordinary visitor, asked, "Who are you?" Shankara's reply was woven in ten profound Sanskrit verses — the Dashashloki Stuti — 'I am neither the earth, nor water, nor fire, nor air, nor sky, nor any of their properties. I am not the senses or the mind even. I am Shiva, the division-less Consciousness.'

Hearing these profound words indicative of great spiritual enlightenment, Shri Govinda Bhagavatpada was delighted. In observance of the customary rules for establishing the relationship between the teacher and the disciple, the Sage extended His Feet through the mouth of the cave, which the disciple worshipped with all devotion.

One may have an inborn knowledge of the Truth, but the scriptures say that one must be instructed by a Guru. Even Lord Rama, despite being an *avatara* of Lord Vishnu, approached Sage Vasishtha and received instruction from Him. Lord Krishna too accepted formal instruction and honoured His Guru, Sage Sandipani. Likewise, Shankara performed the worship of his Guru, and through devoted service, became the object of his Guru's loving affection.
